## History of the Renthof:

We invite you to take part in a tour of discovery through our hotel & restaurant.

To begin with, you have already entered the Renthof through a Renaissance portal, in which Landgrave Moritz placed his coat of arms 400 years ago after he, as architect, had the building converted into a knights' academy.

On the way to the lounge, you walked past the hotel lobby and the well-stocked, extraordinary library, which is intended for conferences and celebrations for up to 20 people.

You were here in the oldest part of the building ensemble - a Carmelite monastery dating back to 1298.

### A quick overview of the history

The building complex of the Kassel Renthof has undergone numerous transformations in its more than 700-year history. Originally built in the 13th century as a Carmelite monastery, it has reinvented itself time and again over the years and adapted to the present day. Under Landgrave Moritz von Hessen-Kassel, for example, it first served as a court school and then as a knights' academy. It later became part of the University of Kassel / Marburg until Hessian higher authorities and courts settled there. While the city was almost completely destroyed during the Second World War and robbed of its old identity, the Kassel Renthof was largely spared, so that after 1945 the Verein für Volkswohl (Association for the People's Welfare) was able to take it over and use it as a living space for senior citizens until 2012.

Now, in spring 2017, the Renthof Kassel is opening a new chapter after being renovated in line with its listed status: The team led by restaurateur Rainer Holzhauer and Kirstin and Uwe Kleinkauf (WELL Group) is opening a privately run boutique hotel with a restaurant, bar and the Brüderkirche church attached to the building complex as an event location in order to breathe new life into the oldest building in Kassel city centre.

### The hotel

The 55 rooms and suites are between 11 and 50 square metres in size, depending on the category, and each one is unique in its layout and design. The mix of styles in the different parts of the building from different centuries is reflected in the room furnishings and gives each room its own individual character.

While the furnishings of the rooms in the east wing are characterised by elements and colours from the 1960s, the south wing reflects its time of origin in the 18th century. Here, classic, restrained elements and colours playfully take aim at the elegant lines of this era. English style elements dominate the west wing, where strong colour accents, wallpaper décor and accessories take centre stage. Fabrics, wallpaper, furniture, tiles and flooring from all over Europe were carefully selected for these different interiors with the owners' expertise.
